## Time-of-Use Rate Plans

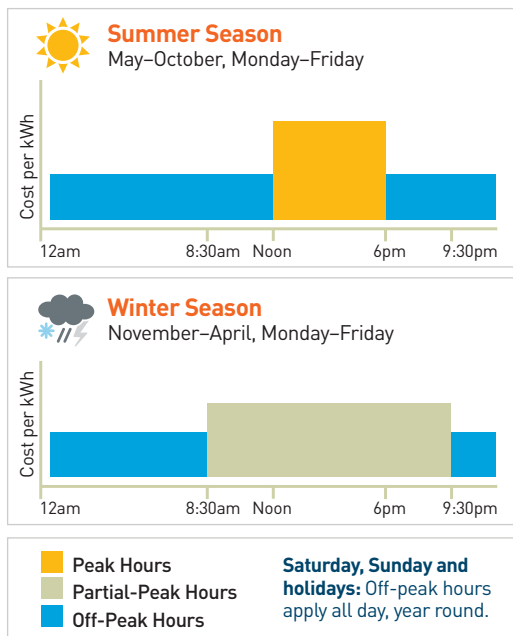
Time-of-Use<sup>1</sup> (TOU) rate plans are electric rate plans in which the price of electricity varies by time of day. Prices are higher during peak hours and lower at all other times.

Agricultural customers with 12 months of interval data who have not yet transitioned to a TOU rate plan will be moved to TOU rates in March of each year.<sup>2</sup>

**Small and Medium Time-of-Use Agricultural Power (AG-4)** is for customers with low to moderate annual operating hours.

**Large Time-of-Use Agricultural Power (AG-5)** is for customers with higher annual operating hours and demand.

AG-4C and AG-5C options have an added partial-peak period in the summer season.

### Changing peak hours

Peak hours will be changing in March 2021 to 5–8pm. Agricultural customers will have the option to enroll early in these new rate plans beginning in March 2020. More information and tools for assessing impacts to your bill will be available at that time.

## Additional Rate Plans or Options

**Peak Day Pricing** combines a Time-of-Use rate with Peak Day Pricing Event Day surcharges.

**Net Energy Metering** allows businesses to install a renewable generator, interconnect to the PG&E grid and receive credits to offset the cost of their energy usage. Program details vary depending on the technology and options you select. <sup>1</sup> For daylight saving time, the time periods shown above will shift one hour later between the second Sunday in March and the first Sunday in April, and between the last Sunday in October and the first Sunday in November.

<sup>2</sup> PG&E's proposal to suspend transitions was adopted in D.18-08-013. Transitions will resume in March 2021.

## Programs to Save Money

### California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE)

program provides agricultural customers a monthly discount on energy bills for qualified agricultural employee housing facilities. To learn more about the CARE program, visit [pge.com/care](http://pge.com/care).

**Capacity Bidding Program (E-CBP)** offers incentives to eligible customers for reducing their energy consumption upon request. A customer may only enroll in Schedule E-CBP through an Aggregator.

### Automated Demand Response Incentive (ADR)

offers a one-time incentive to help pay for the installation of automated controls to shed load during a demand response event upon a signal sent by PG&E. Requires enrolling in a demand response program.
