

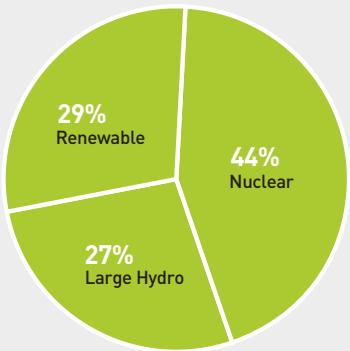


Where your electricity comes from
