**Subject: Updates to Pacific Gas and Electric Company's Remote Grid Initiative Tariff Deviation Customers**

**Purpose**

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph (OP) 5 of Resolution (Res.) E-5132, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) is filing a Tier 1 Advice Letter to update its internal list of remote grid customers served under the tariff deviation approved in Res. E-5132. This list reflects remote grid customers served by a remote grid as of the end of 2024.

**Background**

In accordance with OP 5 of Resolution E-5132, PG&E will submit annually a Tier 1 Advice Letter to update its internal list of remote grid customers served under the tariff deviation approved in Res. E-5132 (the "Remote Grid Customer List"). PG&E describes the updates to its Remote Grid Customer List below and in Attachments A and B to this Advice Letter. Attachment A contains public information regarding the deployment of Remote Grids from 2021 through 2024 and responds to Res. E-5132's recognition that while "PG&E may consider this internal list confidential," it "should strive to make some amount of reporting publicly available so that these initial projects can be referenced."<sup>1</sup> Attachment B provides the updated list of remote grid customers served by a remote grid as of the end of 2024. Attachment B is confidential as described in the accompanying Declaration dated March 27, 2025.

**Request**

PG&E is submitting as Attachment B to this Advice Letter its Remote Grid Customer List, including five new meters (corresponding to five unique customers) that PG&E began serving with Remote Grid Standalone Power Systems in 2024. As of the end of 2024, there are eleven operational Remote Grid Standalone Power Systems, and there are seventeen meters served (corresponding to sixteen unique customers).
