**Purpose**

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits to the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission or CPUC) for approval supplemental modifications to PG&E's standard indemnity clause as it appears on Gas and Electric Sample Form 62-4527 – *Agreement to Perform Tariff Schedule Related Work* in compliance with Resolution G-3561.

**Background**

Gas and Electric Sample Form 62-4527 – *Agreement to Perform Tariff Schedule Related Work* is an agreement that is used for customers requesting PG&E perform tariff related work. This may include work associated with relocations of existing facilities, added facilities and other work associated with providing gas and/or electric service to a customer that PG&E may perform.

On July 26, 2019, PG&E submitted Advice 4126-G/5597-E requesting authorization to modify Form 62-4527 by adding a parenthetical statement at the end of Section 2 that will allow PG&E the flexibility to modify the scope of the indemnity clause when entering into an agreement with the Governmental Agency. The revised agreement will then be submitted to the Commission for approval as a Tier 1 Advice Letter instead of a Tier 3 Advice Letter, as is currently required.

On March 12, 2020, the Commission approved Resolution G-3561, that approved Advice 4126-G/5597-E with the conditions that:

- 1) PG&E will include a reference to Resolution G-3561 in the Form 62-4527 indemnity clause; and

2) PG&E shall include the justification for the indemnity clause modification in each Tier 1 Advice Letter submitted.

In Compliance with Ordering Paragraph (OP) 2 of Resolution G-3561, PG&E is resubmitting Form 62-4527 that includes a reference to the Resolution number in the parenthetical statement.

### **Tariff Revisions**

Revisions to Gas and Electric Form 62-4527 – *Agreement to Perform Tariff Schedule Related Work* can be found on Attachment 1 of this advice letter. For your convenience, a redline version of Form 62-4527 can be found on Attachment 2 that includes revisions made in Advice 4126-G/5597-E and Advice 4126-G-A/5597-E-A. Only the gas version of Form 62-4527 is being provided in the redline version, since the gas and electric versions of the forms are identical.

The submittal would not increase any current rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any rate schedule or rule.

### **Protests**

Pursuant to CPUC General Order 96-B, Section 7.5.1, PG&E hereby requests the protest period be waived.

### **Effective Date**

Pursuant to General Order (GO) 96-B, Rule 5.1, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation. PG&E requests that this Tier 1 advice submittal become effective upon date of submittal, which is March 17, 2020.
