**Purpose**

For Information Only, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits this advice letter (AL), in accordance with Ordering Paragraph (OP) 6 of Decision (D.) 13-01-039, to inform the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission or CPUC) in advance of an anticipated non-utility vacancy on PG&E's Nuclear Decommissioning Trust Fund Committee (Committee).

**Background**

The Nuclear Decommissioning Trusts (NDT) require, among other things, that they be managed by a Committee composed of five members, three of whom are not affiliated with PG&E. The Trusts require that the Committee members be nominated by the management of PG&E and confirmed with the Board of Directors. Additionally, the Trusts require that the Committee members not affiliated with PG&E be confirmed by the Commission.

On January 24, 2013, the Commission issued Decision (D.) 13-01-039; in phase 2 of the 2009 Nuclear Decommissioning Cost Triennial Proceeding. In Ordering Paragraph (OP) 6, the Commission directed each utility to submit an information-only Advice Letter to inform the Commission of non-utility vacancies on the Committee. The Commission directed the utilities to file an AL to identify any upcoming expiration of a non-utility Committee member's term during the year, and for an unexpected vacancy, to file within 30 days of the date the utility has knowledge the vacancy will occur.

**Notice of Trust Fund Committee Vacancy**

PG&E hereby notifies the Commission that, on June 1, 2020 Susan Muranishi, a nonaffiliated Committee member, notified PG&E of her intent to resign from the Committee effective June 30, 2020. As required by D.13-01-039, PG&E is notifying the Commission within 30 days of the date it learned the vacancy will occur.

In accordance with PGE's previous searches for new Committee members, PG&E will conduct a thorough due diligence search for a well-qualified replacement candidate to recommend to the PG&E Board of Directors. PG&E will use its network of diverse businesses' financial leaders to recruit qualified candidates for consideration in the search for its new member of the Committee. Once the Board of Directors approves the candidate nomination, PG&E will file a Tier 2 Advice Letter pursuant to OP 7 of D.13-01-039 requesting Commission approval of the candidate.

This filing will not result in an increase in any rates or charges, conflict with any schedules or rules, nor cause withdrawal of service.

**Protests**

This is an information-only advice letter submittal. Pursuant to General Order 96-B Section 6.2, PG&E is not seeking relief through this advice letter and is not subject to protest.

**Effective Date**

PG&E believes this AL is subject to Energy Division disposition and should be classified as Tier 1 (effective pending disposition) pursuant to GO 96-B. This filing is pursuant to OP 6 of D.13-01-039 and therefore PG&E requests this AL become effective June 10, 2020, the date filed.

**Notice**
