<u>Subject:</u> Correction to the D-CARE Percentage Discount Applied to the Timeof-Use Meter Charge Rate Component for Schedules E-6 and EM-TOU

#### <u>Purpose</u>

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) submits this Tier 1 advice letter to inform the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission or CPUC) of an error recently discovered in PG&E's electric rates that were implemented on March 1, 2020 in Advice 5769-E. When implementing electric rates effective March 1, 2020, PG&E applied the incorrect D-CARE percentage discount on the Time-of-Use (TOU) Meter Charge rate component for Schedules E-6 and EM-TOU.

#### **Background**

On March 1, 2020, PG&E first implemented Schedule D-CARE pursuant to D.18-12-004 and Advice Letter 5758-E. California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) customers taking service on Schedule D-CARE receive a percentage discount on their total bundled charges on their otherwise applicable rate schedule. When implementing this rate, effective March 1, 2020, PG&E did not apply the correct Schedule D-CARE percentage discount to the TOU Meter Charge for CARE customers taking service on Schedules E-6 and EM-TOU. Instead of applying a discount of approximately 35 percent¹ to the TOU Meter Charge for these schedules, PG&E incorrectly maintained the 20 percent discount that was previously in place on separate stand-alone CARE Schedules EL-6 and EML-TOU. Accordingly, all affected customers are due a small refund of \$0.03759 per billing day, or approximately \$1.13 per month.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> As noted in Advice 5758-E, to achieve an overall CARE discount of 35.0 percent while still discounting the delivery minimum bill amount by 50 percent, the Schedule D-CARE line-item discount for energy charges must be set at slightly less than 35.0 percent.

#### Plan for Correction

PG&E plans to correct the Schedule D-CARE discount percentage applied to the TOU Meter Charge for Schedules E-6 and EM-TOU on October 1, 2020. PG&E will correctly apply the discount percentage contained in the Schedule D-CARE tariff.

PG&E estimates that approximately 130 customers have been impacted by this error. As a result, PG&E plans to issue a bill credit to each customer impacted to refund the overpaid amount. PG&E estimates that this credit will be approximately \$8.04 per customer, plus applicable Utility Users Tax (UUT). For the seven-month refund "subject period" of March 1, 2020 through September 30, 2020, PG&E estimates that the total aggregate refund will amount to approximately \$1,000. For ease, PG&E plans to give a flat refund amount of \$8.04 plus UUT to each affected customer, rather than a more detailed calculation based on the number of days of service for each individual customer during the refund subject period.
