**Purpose**

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits this Supplemental Tier 1 Advice Letter (AL) to supplement Advice Letter 4433-G/6196-E (original AL) regarding the appointed directors and officers of PG&E ShareCo LLC (ShareCo).

**Background**

On May 17, 2021, PG&E submitted the original AL in accordance with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC or Commission) Decision (D.) 97-12-088, Appendix A, Rule VI.B, as modified by D.98-08-035 and D.06-12-029 (the Decisions). PG&E is required to notify the Commission of the creation of any affiliate covered by the Commission's Affiliate Transaction Rules (Rules) as described in the Decisions. Accordingly, PG&E filed the original AL to notify the Commission of the creation of a new affiliate entitled PG&E ShareCo LLC.

When the original AL was submitted, PG&E Corporation had not yet assumed ownership of ShareCo or appointed the officers and board for ShareCo, so PG&E committed to filing a supplemental advice letter with the Commission providing this additional information once available. This information is provided in Attachment A to this AL.
