Subject: Supplemental: Establishment of the Wildfire and Natural Disaster Resiliency Rebuild Program Balancing Account

Purpose

This supplemental advice letter corrects a few typographical errors that appear in Advice Letter (AL) 6431-E, which establishes the Wildfire Natural Disaster Resiliency Rebuild Program (WNDRR) Balancing Account to track the payment to Southern California Edison Company (SCE), the program administrator and contract agent, and the recovery of that payment from residential customers over one year via non-bypassable Public Purpose Program (PPP) charges. This advice letter is submitted pursuant to Decision (D.) 21-11-002, Ordering Paragraph 2(g), issued on November 9, 2021.

This supplemental advice letter makes minor revisions to AL 6431-E. While the cover letter and summary sheet are being updated, the new balancing account submitted in AL 6431-E remains unchanged.

Background

As required by D.21-11-002, Ordering Paragraph 2 (g), “[E]ach IOU, except SCE, shall submit a Tier 1 Advice Letter within 30 days from the issuance of this decision to establish a WNDRR Program Balancing Account to record (1) payment to SCE to fund the WNDRR Program and recovery of that payment from residential customers over one year via non-bypassable PPP charges.”¹

On December 9, 2021, PG&E submitted AL 6431-E to establish Electric Preliminary Statement Part JH, Wildfire Natural Disaster Resiliency Rebuild Program Balancing Account (WNDRRPBA-E), pursuant to D.21-11-002. The new balancing account was effective upon submittal on December 9, 2021.
