Subject: Presentation of GHG Credits on Customers' Bills

Purpose

The purpose of this Advice letter is to notify the Commission of the change in billing methodology in which Utility Users' Tax (UUT) will be applied on gross energy charges, prior to applying the Greenhouse Gas (GHG) credits on customers' bills.

Background

On October 17, 2013, the California Public Utility Commission (CPUC) issued Resolution E-4611 which, among other things, required PG&E to submit sample bills showing a separate line item for the GHG credit. In compliance with Ordering Paragraph 6 (OP 6) of the resolution, PG&E submitted Advice 4318-E with the sample bills. The GHG credit was shown on the sample bills as a separate line item followed by a line item showing a reduction in UUT for those jurisdictions which impose UUT on customers in that jurisdiction. UUT is not part of PG&E's rate structure, rather PG&E collects UUT on behalf of the municipal jurisdictions.

Applying UUT to gross energy charges

On March 17, 2021, the Second District of the California Court of Appeals issued a decision in *City of Torrance v. Southern California Edison*, 61 Cal.App.5th 1071 (2021), which ruled that UUT collected from SCE's customers in the City of Torrance should be computed based on gross energy charges, prior to applying the GHG credit.

Although PG&E as not a party to the Torrance case, it had followed the same billing methodology that was challenged in the proceeding. Accordingly, in compliance with the court's decision, effective with bills issued in April 2022, PG&E will apply UUT on gross energy charges, prior to applying the GHG credit, and the line item showing a reduction in UUT will no longer appear on customers' bills. The separate line item for the GHG credits will be retained.

Tariff Revisions

There are no tariff revisions necessary for the change in billing methodology in which UUT is applied on gross energy charges, prior to applying the GHG credits.
