Subject: Updates to Pacific Gas and Electric Company's Remote Grid Initiative Tariff Deviation Customers**Purpose**

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph (OP) 5 of Resolution (Res.) E-5132, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) is submitting a Tier 1 Advice Letter to update its internal list of remote grid customers served under the tariff deviation approved in Res. E-5132. This list reflects remote grid customers served by a remote grid in 2021.

Background

In accordance with OP 5 of Resolution E-5132, PG&E will submit annually a Tier 1 Advice Letter to update its internal list of remote grid customers served under the tariff deviation approved in Res. E-5132 (the "Remote Grid Customer List"). PG&E describes the updates to its Remote Grid Customer List below and in Attachments A and B to this Advice Letter. Attachment A contains public information regarding the deployment of Remote Grids in 2021 and responds to Resolution E-5132's recognition that while "PG&E may consider this internal list confidential," it "should strive to make some amount of reporting publicly available so that these initial projects can be referenced."¹ Attachment B provides the updated list of remote grid customers served by a remote grid in 2021. Attachment B is confidential as described in the accompanying Declaration dated March 25, 2022.
