Purpose

Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") respectfully submits this supplemental Advice Letter to update the cover letter submitted in Advice Letter ("AL") 6617-E. The AL was submitted on June 10, 2022 to request approval to execute a rider and amendment to the Bioenergy Market Adjusting Tariff ("BioMAT") Power Purchase Agreement ("PPA") with Scotts Valley Energy Company, LLC ("Scotts Valley LLC" or "the Counterparty"). Since the filing, Scotts Valley determined it would be more suitable for the counterparty entity to be Scotts Valley Energy Corporation ("Scotts Valley Corp"). PG&E submits this supplemental Advice Letter to correct the name of the counterparty identified for the transaction. This supplemental Advice Letter supplements the original Advice Letter but does not replace it in its entirety.

Background

Scotts Valley Corp is an entity formed under the Tribal Code of the Scotts Valley Band of Pomo Indians and has certain sovereign privileges under Tribal Law which conflict with the terms of the standard BioMAT PPA approved by the Commission. As such PG&E seeks approval to execute a tribal rider and amendment to the BioMAT PPA (the "Tribal Rider") to ensure that the transaction with Scotts Valley Corp remains consistent with the Commission approved BioMAT PPA. PG&E worked with the counterparty to negotiate amendments to the BioMAT PPA in the Tribal Rider to provide a clear, limited waiver of tribal sovereign immunity and other terms to enable the BioMAT PPA to function as intended by D.15-09-004 and remain governed by California law.

After the initial filing, Scotts Valley changed their name for the transaction from Scotts Valley Energy Company, LLC to Scotts Valley Energy Corporation, finding that the entity Scotts Valley Energy Corporation was more capable of providing the limited waiver of

tribal sovereign immunity. PG&E has reviewed the new entity's formation and resolution documents to confirm that it is validly existing and authorized to provide the limited waiver. No changes are required to the Tribal Rider as originally submitted in AL 6617-E.

Protests

Pursuant to GO 96-B, General Rule 7.5.1, PG&E requests to maintain the original protest and comment period designated in Advice 6617-E and not reopen the protest period.

Pursuant to General Order (GO) 96-B, Rule 5.2, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 3 designation. PG&E requests that this Tier 3 advice submittal become effective upon Commission approval.
