Subject: Pacific Gas and Electric Company's Closure of the Non-Residential C-SmartAC Tariff

Purpose

In compliance with Resolution E-5103, Ordering Paragraph (OP) 4, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) submits this advice letter (AL) to close the non-residential C-SmartAC tariff (Electric Schedule E-CSAC).

Background

On April 1, 2020, PG&E submitted AL 5799-E in compliance with California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC or Commission) Decision (D.) 16-09-056 to address various Commission directives and a request by the Commission's Energy Division to discuss the status and scope of the Mid-Cycle Review of PG&E's demand response (DR) programs for 2018-2022. In AL 5799-E, PG&E proposed to cease actively marketing the non-residential C-SmartAC tariff for the balance of the 2018-2022 funding cycle and close the tariff because it has been inactive. PG&E explained that the non-residential C-SmartAC tariff is inactive because it was closed to new non-residential enrollments pursuant to D.12-04-045 and there are no existing participations.¹

On August 4, 2022, the Commission adopted Resolution E-5103, which approved PG&E's proposal in AL 5799-E to close the C-SmartAC tariff. The Commission directed PG&E to submit a Tier 1 AL within 30 days of the Resolution's effective date (August 4, 2022) to implement the tariff changes necessary to close the C-SmartAC tariff.²

Tariff Revisions

PG&E's Electric Schedule E-CSAC tariff includes the provisions for the non-residential SmartAC program. In compliance with Resolution E-5103, OP 4, PG&E proposes to retire Electric Schedule E-CSAC.

The affected tariff sheets are listed on the enclosed Attachment A. The affected tariff will be completely removed, and deleted from our tariff table. Therefore PG&E is not providing a redlined version of the revised tariffs
