Subject: Clean-Up of Gas and Electric Preliminary Statements

Purpose

As part of periodic reviews of its tariff book, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) has identified obsolete accounts that are no longer used. As a result, PG&E submits this Tier 2 advice letter to retire gas and electric preliminary statements for balancing and memorandum accounts that are no longer needed.

The affected tariff sheets are provided in Attachment 1.

Retire Obsolete Gas and Electric Preliminary Statements

Gas Preliminary Statement BS and Electric Preliminary Statement Part EM – ClimateSmart Balancing Account (CSBA)

Decision (D.) 06-012-032 approved PG&E's Climate Protection Program application and allowed PG&E to establish the CSBA to track premiums from participating customers to use toward GHG-reduction projects. The program has been closed to new customers since 2012. These balancing accounts have a \$0 balance and are no longer required.

Electric Preliminary Statement FM – Diablo Canyon Seismic Studies Balancing Account (DCSSBA)

D.10-08-003 established the DCSSBA to record and track actual costs associated with conducting seismic studies and implementing and managing PG&E's Long-Term Seismic Program (LTSP). D.20-12-005 approved PG&E's proposal in its 2020 General Rate Case (GRC) to review future LTSP costs in the GRC and close the DCSSBA.¹ At the time the 2020 GRC Decision was approved, the closure of the account was pending review of the 2019 DCSSBA balance in PG&E's ERRR Compliance Review proceeding. D.21-07-013

approved the recovery of \$3.996 million final balance in the DCSSBA, resolving the last remaining issue. As a result, PG&E transferred the balance from the DCSSBA to the Portfolio Allocation Balancing Account. The DCSSBA now has a \$0 balance and is no longer required.

Gas Preliminary Statement EB – Natural Gas Leak Abatement Program Memorandum Account (NGLAPMA)

D.17-06-015 established the NGLAPMA to track incremental administrative costs related to minimizing methane emissions. D.20-12-005 adopted PG&E's proposal to discontinue the related NGLAPBA,² whose purpose was to track the incremental cost of pilot projects and research and development related to minimizing methane emissions. PG&E has never recorded costs to the NGLAPMA, and the account is not needed.

Electric Preliminary Statement HP – San Joaquin Valley Disadvantaged Communities Data Gathering Plan Memorandum Account (SJVDAC DGPMA)

D.18-08-019 established the SJVDAC DGPMA to track and record costs associated with gathering baseline data on energy, household and community conditions within SJV disadvantaged communities. Activity associated with this program has concluded; the SJVDAC DGPMA has a \$0 balance; and the account is no longer needed.

Electric Preliminary Statement CH – Utility Retained Generation Income Tax Memorandum Account (URGITMA)

D.02-04-016 established the URGITMA to track the consequences of timing differences between income tax revenue requirements for current income tax recorded in PG&E's URG-related balancing accounts and actual URG-related income tax payments made by PG&E. No costs have ever been recorded to this account since it was established in 2003, and the account is not needed.
