Purpose

As part of periodic reviews of its tariff book, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) has identified obsolete tariffs that are no longer used. As a result, PG&E submits this Tier 2 advice letter to retire Electric Schedule E-31, the Distribution Bypass Deferral Rate, and Electric Preliminary Statement Part CK, Distribution Bypass Deferral Rate Memorandum Account.

The affected tariff sheets are provided in Attachment 1.

Retire Obsolete Rate Schedule and Related Preliminary Statement

Electric Schedule E-31 – Distribution Bypass Deferral Rate

Resolution E-3801 approved Electric Schedule E-31, the Distribution Bypass Deferral Rate, and the related Distribution Bypass Deferral Rate Memorandum Account. Electric Schedule E-31 allowed PG&E to offer, subject to certain conditions, discounted rates to customers with loads over 20 kilowatts (kW) when those customers receive offers for electric service from an irrigation district at rates lower than the electric utility's tariffed rates. PG&E does not currently have any customers on Electric Schedule E-31 and the rate schedule is no longer needed.

Electric Preliminary Statement Part CK – Distribution Bypass Deferral Rate Memorandum Account (DBDRMA)

As noted above, Resolution E-3801 approved Electric Schedule E-31 and the related DBDRMA. The DBDRMA tracked and recorded the amount of any net discounted revenue resulting from Electric Schedule E-31. Resolution E-4643 allowed PG&E to

recover the final balance in the DBDRMA through its Annual Electric True-Up Advice Letter.¹ The DBDRMA has had a \$0 balance since May 2015 and is no longer required.
