Purpose

This Advice Letter seeks to establish an electric memorandum account pursuant to Ordering Paragraph (OP) 2 of Decision (D.) 22-12-027. OP 2(b)(iii) of the Decision authorizes Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) to establish a memorandum account to track and recover costs of up to \$600,000, plus an additional 15 percent for potential incremental costs (\$690,000).

Background

On December 27, 2022, The California Public Utilities Commission issued D.22-12-027 which requires Investor Owned Utilities (IOUs), such as PG&E, to participate in a nationwide study to improve the Interruption Cost Estimate tool that determines the value of electric reliability. This study, led by the Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory (LBNL), is intended to help determine a reliable method to determine a standard dollar valuation of electric reliability risk for the Reliability Attribute as part of the Commission's Risk Assessment requirements.

Tariff Revisions

In accordance with OP 2(b)(iii) of D.22-12-027, PG&E proposes to establish the following new account:

Interruption Cost Estimate Memorandum Account (ICEMA) – Electric Preliminary Statement Part JS

The purpose of the ICEMA is to track and record the incremental expenses incurred by PG&E for participating in the development of the ICE 2.0 Calculator led by Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory. PG&E may record participation expenses up to \$600,000 plus an additional 15 percent in the ICEMA for recovery through a future application or as otherwise determined by the Commission.

1. **PURPOSE:** The purpose of the Interruption Cost Estimate Memorandum Account (ICEMA) is to track and record the incremental expenses that PG&E incurs from participating in the development of the ICE 2.0 calculator led by Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory, up to \$600,000 plus an additional 15 percent, pursuant to Decision (D.) 22-12-027.
2. **APPLICABILITY:** Applicability of the ICEMA will be determined by the Commission.
3. **REVISION DATE:** Disposition of the balances in this account will be through a future application or as otherwise determined by the Commission.
4. **RATES:** The ICEMA does not have a rate component.
5. **ACCOUNTING PROCEDURE:** The following entries will be made to this account each month or as applicable:
 - a. A debit entry equal to incremental expenses related to the development of the ICE 2.0 calculator;
 - b. A credit or debit entry, as appropriate, to record the transfer of amounts to or from other accounts, upon approval by the Commission; and
 - c. An entry equal to the interest on the average of the balance in this account at the beginning of the month and the balance in this account after the above entries at a rate equal to one-twelfth the interest rate on three month Commercial paper for the previous month, as reported in the Federal Reserve Statistical Release, H.15, or its successor.
