Subject: Revision to Form 62-4527 – Agreement to Perform Tariff Schedule Related Work

Purpose

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits to the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission or CPUC) for approval modifications to PG&E's standard indemnity clause as it appears on Gas and Electric Sample Form 62-4527 – *Agreement to Perform Tariff Schedule Related Work*.

Background

Gas and Electric Sample Form 62-4527 – *Agreement to Perform Tariff Schedule Related Work* is an agreement that is used for customers requesting PG&E perform tariff related work. This may include work associated with relocations of existing facilities, added facilities and other work associated with providing gas and/or electric service to a customer that PG&E may perform.

Section 2 of the Agreement includes an express indemnification provision under which the applicant indemnifies and holds harmless PG&E against claims of loss, damage or liability associated with the work, except to the extent such loss, damage or liability is caused by the active negligence or willful misconduct of PG&E. Over the years PG&E has submitted advice letters to accommodate requests of various Governmental Agencies who have objected to the scope of the indemnification provision on Form 62-4527 on grounds that it is not limited to the loss, damage or liability caused directly by the Governmental Agency. These agencies include University of California - Davis (Advice 3992-G/5332-E & Advice 4396-E), City of Piedmont (Advice 3490-E), California Department of Water Resources (DWR) (Advice 3461-E & Advice 5541 [Withdrawed]), County of Placer (Advice 2901-G/3206-E) and University of California – Merced (Advice 2898-G/3196-E).

The advice letters mentioned above were submitted pursuant to General Rule 9.2.3 of CPUC General Order (GO) 96-B, that allows PG&E to provide tariffed service to a government agency under terms and conditions otherwise deviating from its tariffs then in effect. By submitting the advice letter under this provision which was effective upon submittal, PG&E was able to revise the indemnification language to accommodate the concerns raised by the governmental agencies and proceed with the requested work in a timely manner.

PG&E anticipates that Governmental Agencies are likely to continue to raise concerns about the scope of PG&E's indemnification provision on Form 62-4527. To accommodate these concerns, PG&E is requesting approval to revise the language on the agreement by adding a parenthetical at the end of Section 2 that will allow PG&E the flexibility to modify the scope of the indemnity clause when entering into an agreement with the Governmental Agency. The revised agreement will then be submitted to the Commission for approval as a Tier 1 Advice Letter.

The proposed revisions to the agreement will streamline the approval process of the advice letter when requesting modifications to the standard indemnification provision and will allow PG&E to submit the advice letter without using the provisions of General Rule 9.2.3 of GO 96-B.

Tariff Revisions

Revisions to Gas and Electric Form 62-4527 – *Agreement to Perform Tariff Schedule Related Work* can be found on Attachment 1 of this advice letter. For your convenience, a redline version of Form 62-4527 can be found on Attachment 2. Only the gas version of Form 62-4527 is provided in redline version, since the gas and electric versions of the forms are identical.

The submittal would not increase any current rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any rate schedule or rule.
