**Purpose**

In compliance with Decision (D.) 19-09-027, *Decision Establishing a Self-Generation Incentive Program Equity Resiliency Budget, Modifying Existing Budget Incentives, Approving Carry-Over of Accumulated Unspent Funds, and Approving \$10 Million to Support the San Joaquin Valley Disadvantaged Community Pilot Projects*, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits this Tier 1 advice filing with the final financial data for each Self Generation Incentive Program's (SGIP) budget as of December 31, 2019.

**Background**

On September 18, 2019 the California Public Utilities Commission issued D.19-09-027, *Decision Establishing a Self-Generation Incentive Program Equity Resiliency Budget, Modifying Existing Budget Incentives, Approving Carry-Over of Accumulated Unspent Funds, and Approving \$10 Million to Support the San Joaquin Valley Disadvantaged Community Pilot Projects*, in which Ordering Paragraph 7(c) states, "Each [program administrator shall] submit a Tier 1 advice letter on January 31, 2020 that contains their final SGIP accounting data as of December 31, 2019 using the format indicated in D.09-12-047."
