Subject: Request to Remove Pacific Gas and Electric Company's Electric Schedule E-6 as a Self-Generation Incentive Program (SGIP) Approved Rate

Purpose

Pursuant to Decision (D.)19-08-001 Pacific Gas & Electric Company (PG&E) submits this advice letter (AL) to remove PG&E's Electric Schedule E-6 from the list of SGIP-approved rates.

Background

On August 9, 2019, the Commission issued D.19-08-001 establishing greenhouse gas emission (GHG) requirements for the SGIP storage budget and requiring new SGIP residential projects to be on a time varying rate with a 1.69 or greater differential between the summer peak and off-peak period, and a peak period starting at or after 4 pm, if such a rate is available to the customer. The Decision also states: "PA advice letters proposing SGIP-eligible rates may also state if, in the PA's view, a previously approved IOU or non-IOU rate may no longer qualify for SGIP purposes and why."¹

Discussion

PG&E's Electric Schedule E-6 is currently an SGIP-approved rate. However, Schedule E-6 was closed to new customers effective May 31, 2016, and as of January 2023, all legacy E-6 customers are being transitioned to Electric Schedule E-TOU-C (unless they instead prefer to take service under an existing optional schedule).² Therefore, Schedule E-6 is no longer available. Schedule E-TOU-C is already an SGIP-Approved rate.

Accordingly, Schedule E-6 should be removed from the list of SGIP-approved rates.
