Subject: Notification of the Creation of Affiliate Relationship with EMBERPOINT LLC

Purpose

In accordance with the California Public Utilities Commission (the CPUC or Commission) Decision (D.) 97-12-088, Appendix A, Rule VI.B, as modified by D.98-08-035 and D.06-12-029 (the Decisions), Pacific Gas and Electric Company (“the Utility”) is required to notify the Commission of the creation of any affiliate covered by the Commission’s Affiliate Transaction Rules (Rules) as described in the Decisions. Accordingly, the Utility hereby notifies the Commission of the creation of an affiliate relationship with a new affiliate named EMBERPOINT LLC (EMBERPOINT).

As required by Rule VI. B., the Utility previously notified Commission staff on January 28, 2026, and posted notice of the creation of an affiliate relationship with EMBERPOINT on its affiliate transaction World Wide Web site at: [Affiliate Transactions \(pge.com\)](http://Affiliate Transactions (pge.com))

Rule VI. B. pertains to compliance plans for new affiliates subject to the rules:

Upon the creation of a new affiliate the utility shall immediately notify the Commission of the creation of the new affiliate, as well as posting notice on its electronic bulletin board. No later than 60 days after the creation of this affiliate, the utility shall file an advice letter with the Energy Division of the Commission. The advice letter shall state the affiliate’s purpose or activities, whether the utility claims that Rule II B makes these Rules applicable to the affiliate, and shall include a demonstration to the Commission that there are adequate procedures in place that will ensure compliance with these Rules. Background

On January 23, 2026, PG&E Corporation acquired a potential ownership interest in EMBERPOINT via a Simple Agreement for Future Equity. EMBERPOINT is a new business venture between Lockheed Martin Evolve LLC, PG&E Corporation, Salesforce, and Wells Fargo. EMBERPOINT’s business purpose is to develop and commercialize next-generation wildfire solutions aimed at mitigating catastrophic wildfires. PG&E

Corporation's investment in EMBERPOINT is funded by PG&E Corporation shareholders. Based on this investment by PG&E Corporation, the Utility has considered EMBERPOINT an affiliate under Rule I.A of the Affiliate Transaction Rules since January 23, 2026. Though EMBERPOINT's business purpose does not directly relate to the use of gas or electricity, out of an abundance of caution the Utility is also treating EMBERPOINT as an affiliate under Rule II.B of the Affiliate Transaction Rules.

Unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission, the Utility will apply the provisions of its 2025 Affiliate Transaction Rules Compliance Plan (Compliance Plan), submitted on June 30, 2025 via Advice Letter 5081-G/7629-Es, to any transactions between the Utility and EMBERPOINT. The Utility's Compliance Plan and Guidance Documents comprehensively addresses relevant transactions and communications with its affiliates, including EMBERPOINT. If the Commission modifies or requires amendment of the Utility's current and prevailing compliance plan, or in the event that the Utility submits a periodic update to its compliance plan, the Utility will apply all such changes or the provisions of such amended plans to this affiliate.
