INFORMATION, ACTS AND FUNCTIONS AUTHORIZED – This authorization provides authority to the Agent. The Agent will provide this completed form with their electronically submitted application (Electric Form 79-1226) requesting an appointment to enable meter socket adapter (hereafter "Device") installation, removal, or related activity.

I (Customer) authorize my Agent to act on my behalf to request PG&E to visit my premises in order to install, remove, or enable the installation or removal of a Device. I agree to at all times indemnify, defend, and hold harmless PG&E from any and all damages, losses, claims, and actions, including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys' fees and costs, and all expenses incidental to, based upon or arising out of damage to property or injuries to persons in any way arising out of or related to the Device, including but not limited to its installation and removal, except to the extent that such damages, losses, claims, or actions are directly caused by the negligence or willful misconduct of PG&E.

I acknowledge that all Devices must abide by all aspects of PG&E Electric Rule 31 and/or a Testing and Evaluation Pilot Agreement as each may be applicable, including, but not limited to, the following general provisions that are more specifically detailed in the Rule:

AUTHORIZATION TO ACT AS AGENT TO REQUEST PG&E WORK

- Only PG&E personnel and/or PG&E's authorized agents are permitted to remove or reinstall a PG&E meter. Not Applicants, their agent, or any non-PG&E third-party may access, or otherwise breach the seal surrounding PG&E's electric meter. If installation of the Device requires removal of the PG&E meter, removal and reinstallation of the meter must be performed by PG&E or PG&E's authorized agents. In some instances, PG&E or its agents may also install the Device.
- Not by inspection, if any, non-rejection, nor in any other way, does PG&E give any express or implied warranty as to the adequacy, safety, or other characteristics of any structures, equipment, wires, appliances or devices owned or maintained by the Applicants, including without limitation the Device, generating facility, and any structures, equipment, wires, appliances or other devices appurtenant thereto.
- Applicants have sole responsibility for the maintenance of their Device, including any hardware updates, configuration, or other changes, including firmware changes. PG&E has no obligation with respect to the operation or maintenance of a Device.
- Any maintenance of a Device which requires its removal must involve an on-site, qualified PG&E technician who will first remove the PG&E meter to allow a third party to perform maintenance. Requests to enable maintenance must also be electronically submitted to PG&E through the Portal and Applicants or Applicants' agent will pay a one-time fee to PG&E pursuant to Electric Form 79-1226.
- If at any time PG&E determines that the continued operation of the Device may endanger the Company's electric system, operations, or employees, or may have an adverse effect on PG&E's obligation to safely and reliably deliver power to other customers consistent with its tariffs, PG&E shall have the right to disconnect the Device from the Company's electric system at the customer's expense.



AUTHORIZATION TO ACT AS AGENT TO REQUEST PG&E WORK

I (Customer), _____ (print name of authorized signatory), declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that I am the Customer of Record listed at the top of this form and that the Agent has authority to act on my behalf and perform the specific acts and functions listed above, including, without limitation, requesting services from PG&E that may result in charges to me. I further authorize PG&E to disclose my personally identifying information relevant to any such request to my Agent. I understand that PG&E reserves the right to, but may not, verify any authorization request submitted before taking any action on my behalf. I hereby release, hold harmless, and indemnify PG&E from any liability, claims, demands, causes of action, damages, or expenses resulting from: 1) the unauthorized use of this information by my Agent; and 2) from any actions taken by my Agent or PG&E pursuant to this Authorization, including installation and removal of a meter socket adapter. I understand that this agreement at all times shall be subject to such modifications as the California Public Utilities Commission may direct from time to time in the exercise of its jurisdiction.
