The following questions relate to your 2022 WMP Update submission.

QUESTION 07

On page 657, PG&E provides Table 7.3.5-2, which shows planned mileage of ground-based LiDAR on distribution facilities. Please supplement this table by:

- a) Adding a column for planned mileage of aerial LiDAR.
- b) Adding a row with data on actual mileage completed in 2021.

ANSWER 07

- a) No Aerial LiDAR collections are planned as part of the 2022 WMP Initiative 7.3.5.7.
- b) The 2021 collection effort did not have actual mileage targets and the data delivered was not optimized for mileage reporting. Accurate mileage reporting requires an additional vendor deliverable that will be part of the 2022 collection effort. The 2021 collection has been completed, however, the vendor will process the information to allow miles complete for 2021. A new vendor contract to create the required feature for mileage reporting is currently pending PG&E approval. We estimate that the 2021 actual mileage will be available for reporting by Q3 2022.
